English

This half term we will be looking at the story 'Ella and the Ocean', focussing on making predictions, character descriptions, and writing our own stories.

We will continue teaching children our phonics and SCODE. We will be looking at spelling patterns, and will revisit prefixes, suffixes and tenses.

In reading we will be focussing on our inference, checking we fully understand what is going on and why.

You can further support your child at home by reading daily with them and encouraging them to write regularly for a purpose - letters, shopping lists, birthday cards, party invitations etc. Thank you!

Reading and Homework

Your children will bring home their reading book daily. Please encourage them to read as much as possible and ensure that you are listening to them read at least three times per week. Please ensure you are signing their reading record to show what they have read and how they coped and return reading books and record books daily. The children will also bring home a Team Read book which is a book of their choice from our reading library. Homework will be set every <u>Friday</u> to be completed at home and returned by the following <u>Wednesday</u>.
