Maths

In Maths we will be thinking about counting beyond 10, recalling our knowledge of odds / evens /sharing / addition / subtraction to solve problems. We will be learning ways to record our own learning and thinking about how recording methods can help us to solve problems. We will be continuing to ensure children have a solid secure understanding of ways to make all numbers to 10 and that they can recall this guickly and demonstrate an understanding of composition of numbers.

Topic

This half term we will be linking lots of our learning to our theme: 'Sail the Seven Seas!' We will be hearing from a very stinky pirate called Captain Beastlie, learning about facts linked to animals in the ocean and thinking about things that make us special and unique. To support our learning we will be using the texts 'Captain Beastlie's Pirate Party', 'Only one you' and 'The Book of the great big blue'.
