English

This half term we will be looking at the story of The Snail and The Whale. We will be writing descriptions using a range of strategies such as alliteration and similes, focussing also on our use of adjectives and adverbs.

We will also be looking at the features of recounts and writing our own recount from the point of view of a character in the story.

We will continue teaching children phonics and supporting them in learning new spelling patterns and rules.

You can further support your child at home by reading daily with them and encouraging them to write regularly for a purpose - letters, shopping lists, birthday cards, party invitations etc. Thank you!

Your children will bring home their reading book on a **Friday**, and return it on **Monday** if they are reading Little Wandle.
