Fidget ring- 40p

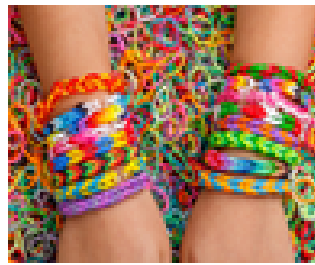
Regular bracelet – 30p
