Year 2 had an amazing trip to blue planet aquarium this week! They saw many different species of fish, shark and even some divers and mermaids!

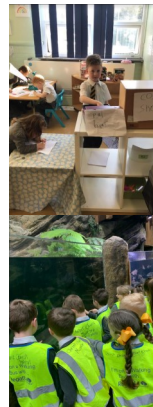
Year 3 started writing their own Egyptian fairy tale and have also been learning about money. They had a lot of fun exchanging change with each other in maths!

After this date only proven newly diagnosed conditions will be considered for this examination date.
