

Maths

In Maths we will be continuing to focus on our rapid recall and knowledge of number bonds to and within 10. We will be thinking about each number to 10, how to add and subtract to make that total; and how to record our learning using number sentences/part whole models/ten frames. We will be using what we know with our number bonds to begin to solve problems with a real life context and purpose.

Topic

This half term we will be learning about our planet Earth, travelling within this and about Space. We will be thinking about the Solar System, our planet, constellations and what it is like to be an astronaut. We will learn about Chris Hadfield and other famous astronauts. We will also be thinking about travelling in planet Earth and going on journeys. We will be looking at maps and globes to support our learning too. We will also spend some time learning about the King's Coronation and celebrating this!

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English

In English we will be using and applying all of our phonic knowledge to read and write sentences linked to our theme and current learning. We will be learning about key writing points such as remember to use a capital letter, finger spaces between words and a full stop at the end of a sentence. We will be writing for a purpose such as planning a journey, creating fact files and recording our thoughts and ideas linked to our texts.
