Pre-school have had great fun collaborating to create an under the sea scene background which they will add their very own fish too! They explored making marks with different items to create the sea.

FS2 have had a lot of fun outdoors this week. They've enjoyed forest school sessions where they watered the allotment beds, they bird watched and have applied their reading skills to read the bird names.

Year 1 have enjoyed using the outdoor area to show their maths skills in different ways. They have also begun to learn about Katie Morag and the Isle of Struay in English and can't wait to read more of her stories as they continue their connected learning theme of 'Island Holidays'.

Year 2 have started looking at their new English Text 'Ella and the Ocean'. The children have enjoyed predicting what the story is about and describing the setting of the story. They have ended the week writing their own imaginary story. We are so proud of how hard the children have worked - lots of positive points have been given out!

Year 3 have had a super first week back. They have started to explore what an information text is and have been researching Fair Trade ready to write their own.

Year 4 have been put to the test this week as they were quizzed on their times tables by other peers and staff members around school. They did a great job.

Year 5 We have had a great first week back. In maths, we have continued to look at different angles and practising using protractor. We have learnt that a straight line angle always equals 180 degrees and a full rotation is 360 degrees. In English, we have been reading on in our text 'Holes' and have created persuasive adverts. We have started learning about tennis in PE and continued to learn more about Extreme Earth in our geography.

Year 6 have enjoyed working on data handling in maths and have also enjoyed starting to learn about and explore the life of Nelson Mandela in English. Their dance for the dance festival on Tuesday 20th June is also starting to take shape!

Nurture class This week nurture class have been getting very creative making watercolour paintings and leaf sun catchers in forest school. They have also been investigating food chains.
