Advance notice of changes

Change to the School Day Timings: The DFE have asked schools to ensure all pupils have the same school hours of 32.5 per week. This means that from September we will only have one end of day time and **all pupils will finish at 3.30pm**. We will send more details about where to collect children from before the start of term. We will also be offering a "Walking Bus" where school staff meet pupils in the Parish centre car park and walk them to and from school to reduce congestion in and around the school entrance and neighbouring roads.

Change to School Meal Charges: We have managed to maintain the cost of our school meals at £2 for the past ten years. However, with increased costs to all elements of meal provision we unfortunately need to increase our charges to be in line with other local schools and enable us to continue the current level of service. Infant pupils will continue to receive free lunches. **Pupils from Years 3 – Year 6 will be charged £2.30 per meal** payable on parent pay. We are sorry to have to impose the increase at such a difficult time for families, but we are losing money and school budgets just can't sustain the costs. If you would like to check if you are eligible for free lunches, please contact the school office who can do an online application with families.

Please remember that school cannot authorise term time holidays and the impact of the pandemic is no longer applicable as exceptional circumstances, so no holidays will be authorised. Please bear term dates in mind when you book!
