Year 2 have enjoyed creating firework posters using onomatopoeia words. They then used these words to help write poems about fireworks!

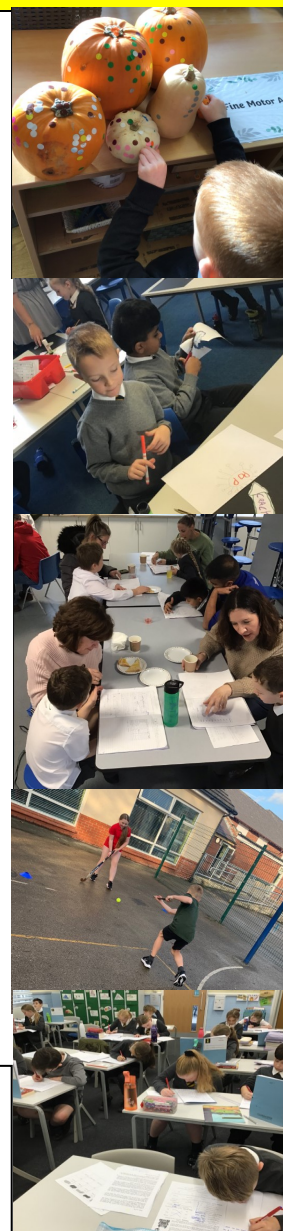
Year 3 have begun their DT project. They are researching existing products and shelters from the past. Year 3 also enjoyed coffee morning with their grown ups this week.
