Pre-school have loved Happy Minds this week, they made friendship bands to give to their friends.

FS2 have enjoyed learning about Advent and the lead up to Christmas this week. They have begun learning all about the story of the first Christmas and are very excited to be preparing to show Nativity performance for their grown-ups in a couple of weeks. They have been exploring the ice outdoors using all of their senses and investigated different ways to melt it; what great experiential learning they have had!

Year 1 have been looking at people who are special to them in PSHE. They talked about why people are special to them and have created certificates to give to their chosen person!

Year 2 have been planning and writing the next chapter of their class text 'Flat Stanley'. They have tried to remember to use different punctuation in their writing and have used different sentence starters.

Year 3 have started looking at multiplying 2-digit numbers in Maths and have completed their non-chronological reports in English. History has involved looking at Stone Age artefacts for clues about our past and they have discovered that Greasby has one of the earliest known human settlements in Merseyside, believed to date from approximately 7000 BC!

Year 4 families were treated to a show-stopping clarinet performance on Tuesday! The children wowed their audience as they played a selection of songs in a class ensemble. Some children even performed in small groups and by themselves too! What a bunch of talented musicians we have in Year 4! Well done children- we are all so proud of you!

Year 5 have enjoyed another busy week of learning. In maths, they are conquering multiplying three by two digits and in English, they have learned how to use colons and semi-colons in sentences. They have learned how to shoot and pass in hockey and are beginning to rehearse for our Value service.

Year 6 have been working hard in DT to research and design their toys incorporating a cam mechanism. Next week, they will be visiting Calday Grange Grammar School to make their products. They are looking forward to sharing them with you!

Nurture class have enjoyed learning all about the Christmas story, and have looked at different ways to solve word problems in maths.
