Look what we have enjoyed this week...

Pre-school have loved having their parents come in to school for their Stay and Play sessions this week!

FS2 have been enjoying learning all about the Lunar New Year. They were very grateful that Anna could visit and teach them all about the traditions her family have at this special time of year. They have learnt about the significance of the colour red, said some colours in Cantonese and even got special red envelopes. The activities in class have helped children to understand the story of the great race, given us chance to explore foods from around the world and we have even made our own music for a dragon dance. The children also had a great time learning how to control their movements and have tension in their body shapes during PE.

Year 1 have consolidated all of their science learning on different animals by making posters showing everything they know. They also became authors and have finished writing their own versions of Little Red Riding Hood with a little twist. In DT, the children have enjoyed doing some more cooking!

Year 2 this week we have been researching facts about blue whales. They have created a fact file using all of their prior learning linked to sentence structures and have been learning about fractions of whole numbers in

Year 3 have started planning their own narratives based on 'New Brighton Cinderella', thinking about characters, setting and plot. In Maths they have started learning about how to create and interpret pictograms and bar graphs. They have used different sources of information in History to research what life was like in Ancient Egypt and some children have decorated their scarab beetles in Art.

Year 4 team have been blown away as the children have been working so hard at home on their Viking research over the last few weeks. This week, arrived a fleet of longships, a bakery of Viking bread as well as poems, posters, weapons and a longhouse too! Well done to the children and their amazing families who have helped and supported this project! Thank you!

Year 5 have enjoyed science, invasion games and learning the differences between Roman houses and Tudor houses.

Year 6 have continued to learn about World War II and have analysed newspaper reports documenting the evacuation of children from Liverpool to Shropshire and Wales. The children have started to use a writer's toolkit to write their own newspaper reports.

Nurture class have enjoyed continuing to share their learning with their classes!
