English

This half term we will be focussing on reading comprehensions and looking at Australian Dreamtime stories. By the end of the unit, we will have written our own Dreamtime story.

We will continue teaching children our Little Wandle phonics and spellings. We will be looking in particular at spelling patterns, prefixes and suffixes. We will also be looking at tenses - past, present and future tenses.

In reading we will be focussing on our comprehension, checking we understand what we are reading and answering questions linked to the text.

You can further support your child at home by reading daily with them and encouraging them to write regularly for a purpose - letters, shopping lists, birthday cards, party invitations etc. Thank you!

Reading and Homework

If your child is a Little Wandle reader they will bring their book home on a Wednesday, to be returned the following Monday. If your child is on Accelerated Reading (AR) books they need to have their home reading record signed three different times before they complete the quiz. They will also bring home a Team Read book which is a book of their choice from our reading library. Homework will be set every Wednesday to be completed at home and returned by the following Wednesday.

Children are encouraged to complete their homework independently, using their phonic knowledge to help them to spell unknown words. **Thank you ☺.**
