Look what we have enjoyed this week...

**Pre-school** A great week in pre school. We had our Happiness Heroes introduce our new module, learnt lots of new facts about London and enjoyed the sand and water areas whilst learning outdoors.

**FS2** have been enjoying learning about countries and places around the world in Literacy this week and have used their phonics skills to write sentences about the new places we have discovered. We have used our number knowledge to solve some problems and have been recording our answers in lots of different ways in maths. The highlight of our week was beginning our new module in My Happy Mind with a fun session led by our Happiness Heroes.

**Year 1** have had a very busy week this week! We have been practising some joining skills in DT ready to build our lighthouses next week and have enjoyed learning about fractions in maths!

**Year 2** have had another busy week. We have started our new unit of work in maths - money. In science we have been looking at different life cycles. We had a lovely time in our forest area where we took part in a year group collective worship. We were thinking about how the world God made fills us with joy.

**Year 3** have been looking at converting minutes to seconds in maths and diary writing in English. It's been fun writing from the perspective of Wilbur the pig from our key text, Charlotte's Web. In science the children dissected a plant to look at all of the different parts and learn about their functions.

**Year 4** In science, Year 4 have enjoyed learning about how we hear sounds, the parts inside the ear and how sound travels. Did you know that the three tiny bones in our ears are called the hammer, anvil and stirrup?

**Year 5** has enjoyed another week of fun learning. We have started our new class text, Holes, in English and developed our athletics skills further in PE. We learned all about the effects of friction in science and started planning our stop motion animations in computing. What a fabulous week.

**Year 6** The writing that Year 6 has produced this week has astounded Miss Cooper and Mrs Lakin. Their use of emotive and descriptive language has been well chosen and effectively used. They have published their writing and have taken great care and pride in doing so. Well done to each and every one of you!
