Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to provide you with a school update and let you know the class arrangements for next year. The reports will tell you if your child is on track within their current year, what their next steps are and any areas they may need support with moving forwards. They also recognise your child's particular strengths and talents, and what we have seen them achieve over this academic year.

As previously notified, our transition day will be on **Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> July**, when our Year 6 pupils visit their High School destinations and the rest of the children will all get to spend the day with their new teachers in their new classrooms for next academic year.

To enable you to see what your child's classroom looks like and meet their new teacher you are invited to pop into your child's new classroom during **our Family Welcome session on Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> July between 3.45-5.30pm**. This is an informal chance to say hello and have a chat with your child's new teacher and familiarise yourself with where their new classroom will be. Your child will have spent the day in their new room, so will be able to show you the way!

Secondary schools should have contacted Y6 parents with arrangements and children will go straight to High School that morning for the full day. We will look forward to hearing how they get on and hope they have an exciting day!
