Foundation Subjects

Geography: children will continue to learn about Port Sunlight during the Victorian Times. They will understand what life was like in Port Sunlight in Victorian times, compared to other towns/cities. They will understand land use patterns in Port Sunlight and the importance of trade links. The unit will conclude with a visit to Port Sunlight.

DT: Children will research and evaluate CAM toy mechanisms to use in their own circus inspired design.

Music: Explore time signatures (6/8 rhythms) through songs and collaborative rhythm games. Explore rhythmic poems and songs such as Plastic Wrap and 1066 Rap.

PSHE: Children will explore aspects of living a healthy lifestyle.

RE & Worship
