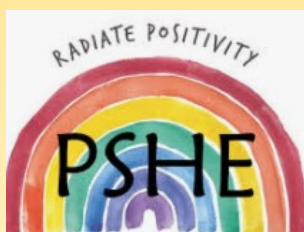
The PSHE Subject Leaders and members of the Senior Leadership Team will be on hand at this session to gather parent views and answer any questions.
