Geography / Science

WHERE IN THE WORLD?

We will be continuing with this topic, focussing on History - researching the History of Flight.

In DT the children are planning, designing, making and evaluating their own form of transport to travel around the world.

Science will be taught through a flight focus week later on this half term.



RE & Worship

In RE this half term we will be learning about the concept 'forgiveness'. We will look at parts of the book of Psalms as we consider the key question:

'How does prayer help Christians start over again?'
