In Maths we will be focusing on our rapid recall and knowledge of number bonds to and within 10. We will be thinking about each number to 10, how to add and subtract to make that total; and how to record our learning using number sentences/part whole models/ten frames.

Topic

This half term we will be linking lots of our learning to our theme: Traditional Tales. We will be thinking about the structure of stories, the characters and settings and using our knowledge and skills to help solve problems in stories such as Jack being captured by the Giant!

English

In English we will be continuing to use our themes and texts to support our learning. We will be continuing to encourage the children to attempt to write captions and sentences independently, using segmenting (sounding out) as a main strategy. We will be thinking about using finger spaces to separate our words and using our writing for a purpose. We will be learning about Traditional Tales, focusing on Jack and the Beanstalk and The Gingerbread Man. Using these stories we will think about how to create our own stories and retell these orally. z\

RE & Worship

In RE we will be learning about the Forgiveness. We will be thinking about times that we might make a mistake and the importance of forgiving. We will learn about how God and Jesus showed forgiveness and consider how we can be like them in our lives. We will learn about Lent and the special time of Easter too.

Homework

Homework this half term will be largely focused on reading at home. We ask that you try to read / re-read the books sent home each weekend a few times to really help your child's fluency. The books sent home should be at a level that your child can read 90% independently, this will support their 'blending in their head' and fluent reading skills. We will continue to share with you weekly new phonic sounds or learning and will update you when further homework will be introduced.
