



FS2 Stay and Play Session

Dear Parents and Carers of FS2 Children

As mentioned in our recent newsletter, the FS2 children and staff would like to invite you to attend a 'Stay and Play Session' next week. The session will be in the FS2 classroom and will give you the opportunity to spend some time in the unit seeing the activities your child is doing whilst at school and join in with them.

We would like to invite **one adult per child** to attend the session. This will be an opportunity for you to see how your child's learning and development has progressed since the start of school, see in practice how we are challenging and extending their learning and will help you to see ways in which you can support their learning at home.

The session will take place on the following days:

Class 1 (Mrs Campbell) – Wednesday 30th March 2022 @ 2.00-3.15pm

Class 2 (Miss Osborne) – Thursday 31st March 2022 @ 2.00-3.15pm

In order to ensure these sessions are as safe as possible, we will have the class not in their Stay and Play session in the hall doing other activities and the FS2 classroom will be kept well ventilated. Thankfully, children and staff in school are remaining well at the moment, however **given the current rise in cases locally, we would ask that if possible you take a lateral flow test prior to attending. We would also ask that if you feeling at all unwell that you do not attend**, whilst we realise you will still want to be in school with your child, there will be other opportunities in the future and we would appreciate your cooperation and support in keeping everyone as safe as possible. Any adult that wishes to wear a mask will be able to but this will not be expected.

If you are able to attend, we would ask that you arrive approximately 5 minutes prior to the start and that you wait by the side buzzer gate. Please DO NOT press the buzzer for the main office, a member of the FS2 team will come to greet you and sign everyone in. Due to limited space and health and safety rules, we are unable to accommodate younger siblings or pushchairs at these sessions.

In order for us to plan effectively, we would ask that you please return the reply slip attached detailing the name and relationship to the child of the adult who is able to attend.
