

Maths

We will continue revising arithmetic, reasoning and problem-solving skills to equip our children well for their education at Secondary School. We shall also complete a unit on financial education, looking at money-related skills.

Science/History

Science: After having started the evolution topic last half term, learning about the palaeontologist Mary Anning, this term the children will continue to further their knowledge regarding evolution and inheritance.
