

Curriculum

We are starting the term by assessing all children in Reading, Writing and Maths. Once we have a baseline of their ability, we will start to close the gaps in these subjects to move their learning on.

In year 2 we follow Maths No Problem, a Singaporean style of maths teaching and will begin with place value, then moving onto calculations.

In English, we are starting with the book 'The Disgusting Sandwich' and will be focussing on basic narrative writing skills.

Our new topic of 'Where in the World?' will start once children are settled into their new routines and assessments are completed.

PE

The Year 2 PE day is Monday.

Children should come to school every Monday dressed in their PE kit. They will also need a waterproof coat each week too.

Children are also asked to bring in a water bottle **every day**.
