

## Maths

**Addition and Subtraction:** Pupils will be exploring addition and subtraction of numbers to 1 000 000. They will begin by using simple strategies to add and subtract, such as counting on and counting back. They will then focus on adding within 1 000 000 and subtracting within 1 000 000. Pupils will use multiple key methods, such as the column method and number bonds to add and subtract numbers.

We will also continue to plug any gaps in basic maths skills- focusing on daily mental fluency (number bonds/times tables/ mental strategies).

## Science/Topic

**Science:** Properties and Changes of Materials

**Topic:** Tudors in our Towns -how did the Tudors help to shape the modern world? Where are the Tudors found on a timeline? How do the Tudors compare to other civilisations/times in history? How did the reformation impact religion throughout history?
