Science

This half term we will be continuing to look at the topic 'Animals including humans'. We focussed last half term on being healthy and will now move on to look at the similarities between all types of animal and what they need to survive. We will also look at the life cycle of different animals. We will be learning this alongside the story 'Monkey Puzzle' and the scientist Jane Goodall.

General

We will continue to do daily PSHE lessons with the children, with a focus on managing emotions. We will be discussing kindness, friendship, feelings and worries.

English

This half term we will be looking at a narrative tale called 'The Snail and The Whale'. We will be linking this to our work on 'Where in the World', thinking about where the snail and the whale may travel to. We will also be writing a recount from the point of view of the snail to describe his adventure.

Homework will continue to be emailed out on a Friday to be completed at home and emailed back to school by the following Wednesday.

We will continue to send reading books home each week and would appreciate these being sent back in on Monday the following week, so that we have time to isolate the books before giving to another child.

Please feel free to continue to access books from Oxford Owl, and also to play TT Rockstars to develop knowledge of multiplication.

Children are encouraged to complete their homework independently, using their phonic knowledge to help them to spell unknown words.
